## **New Youth Protection Program for Scouting America**

Scouting America's Youth Protection Training (YPT) program has been replaced by **Safeguarding Youth.** 

Safeguarding youth is a value at the core of the Scouting movement. It is vital to maintain a culture of active supervision, awareness, and safety at all levels of Scouting. Safeguarding Youth training will help leaders and parents prevent harm to youth and is required for all Scouting America registered volunteers and participating adults. With the implementation of this training, Safegaurding Youth is a joining requirement for new families. Current Scouting families will be required to take the Safeguarding Youth training upon expiration of their YPT training or by May 2026, whichever comes first.
