



Know the RULES

Outlaw Race

- The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- The overall width of the car shall not exceed $2 \frac{3}{4}$ inches.
- The car must have $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " clearance between the wheels.
- The car must have $\frac{3}{8}$ " clearance underneath the body so it does not rub on the track.
- The car shall not exceed 7.0 ounces.
- The official race scale that is used at car check-in shall be considered final.
- The block may be shaped in any way that is desired.
- Pre-built kits are allowed.
- The axles may be altered, polished and lubricated.
- Non-BSA axels and wheels are permissible.
- No loose materials of any kind coming off the car
- Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only race committee members can touch it.
